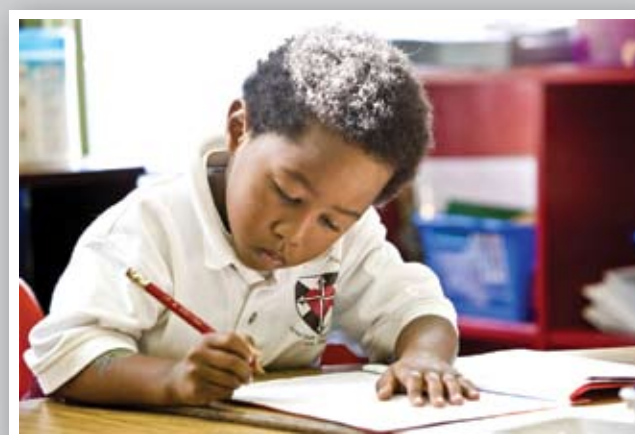

The Golden Apple Award is bestowed upon individuals who exemplify commitment to the ideal that every child in San Francisco has equal access to the very best educational opportunities. Janet and Clint are committed to inner city education and children's organizations in the Bay Area.

*The Megan Furth Catholic Academy commends Janet and Clint Reilly for their exemplary work on behalf of children and education.*

Clint and Janet Reilly are longtime supporters of Megan Furth Academy and Sacred Heart Grammar School. Clint and Janet began contributing to Sacred Heart Grammar School in the Western Addition and Saint Paul of the Shipwreck Grammar School in Hunters Point in 1997. They were at the first meeting organized by Fr. Charles Gagan to save Sacred Heart in 2001. The Reillys also helped raise substantial funds to assist the Alliance of Mission District Catholic Schools.

Today, the Reilly Family Scholarship Fund provides four year high school scholarships for inner city students to attend Sacred Heart Cathedral Prep, Riordan, Immaculate Conception Academy and Mercy High School in San Francisco.

Clint Reilly served on the board of Catholic Charities for ten years and was President of the Board from 2002 thru 2007, having been appointed as the first lay board president by Archbishop William J. Levada.

Janet Reilly is the First Vice President of the Golden Gate Bridge, Highway and Transportation District. She is also President and co Founder of Clinic by the Bay, a nonprofit health clinic providing free care to working, uninsured families in the Excelsior District of San Francisco. This clinic is affiliated with Volunteers in Medicine, which operates clinics across America staffed by retired doctors and nurses.

A strong advocate for culture and the arts, Janet also served on the boards of the Asian Art Museum and the San Francisco Film Society. Janet has also been active in many vital social service organizations, such as Shanti, Mount St. Joseph's-St. Elizabeth's, San Francisco Suicide Prevention, the St. Vincent De Paul Society, Caminos Pathways, St. Anthony's Foundation and the Milton Marks Richmond Library.

Clint Reilly operates their family real estate and hospitality business out of the historic Merchants Exchange Building on California Street. Janet formerly led the Public Relations Department for Mervyn's Department Stores.

Janet and Clint reside in San Francisco with their two daughters Jill and Ava.
